Withdraw ¥1,500-2,000 RMB from Bank of China ATM

Connect to VPN using free airport Wi-Fi

Register WeChat (needed for communication)

🌆 FIRST 24 HOURS IN CHINA

Set up Alipay with foreign card (Profile → Payments → Add Card)

Test mobile payment at 7-Eleven or FamilyMart

Buy essentials: toilet paper, hand sanitizer, bottled water

Download Didi (China's Uber) and Baidu Maps

- X Drink tap water (even for brushing teeth)
- X Assume English is spoken (carry translation app)
- X Discuss politics (Tibet, Taiwan, Tiananmen)

X Rely on Google, WhatsApp, Instagram (they're blocked!)
